**Presentation: Sarah Wagoner, PCHC**

Sarah began by mentioning that PCHC is celebrating their first anniversary this month. A lot of good things have been happening at PCHC, so well in fact, they are discussing the expansion of center.

Dr. Paul Reed is the Medical Provider, Tara Robinson is the part-time Mental Health Provider and Kelly Faltyn is the part-time Nurse Practitioner and will see pediatric patients as well as expecting mothers.

In the past year, the facility has seen 3,700 office visits. They accept Medicare, Medicaid, insured and uninsured patients. The clinic is not a 'FREE CLINIC', there is a fee for services. If a patient is unable to pay for services, a payment schedule is made with that individual. The services are provided on a sliding scale reflective of their income.

Mobil Smiles was in Guymon at PCHC last February. The mobile dental clinic will be returning in March. PCHC staff will be visiting the area schools to screen the children before the unit arrives.

Mission of Mercy is a free dental service provided by state licensed dentists who will do a wide variety of services for free. PCHC will buss 300 Guymon area people for this.

PCHC offers many services that you can find in other clinics and some that are not provided. Drug screens, flu shots, immunizations (Shingles shot is given with patient request at least 24 hours in advance), ODOT physicals, and many more.

Bob Burger helps people with their insurance enrollment.

PCHC is working on more community outreach.

Sarah Wagoner emphasized that PCHC is not in competition with other health care providers or the hospital. They are a supplement to the existing service providers and to the hospital.

Hours are Monday – 8:00 am – 6:00 pm; Tuesday – Friday, 8:00 am – 5:00 pm.
