The following sessions are fundamental in the process in developing your leadership skills. Each session is a unique view in the broad spectrum of Leadership Guymon.

January 29	Reception – Social hour (or two). Meet your classmates, facilitators and alumni. Sorry, you're stag tonight!
February 1	Quality of Life Session – What Guymon has to offer the community for quality of life.
February 8	Community Leadership – Learn about your community, interpersonal communication, personality styles and much more.
February 14 (Thurs.)	Municipal Government Session - This Session features how city government functions. Participants will attend Guymon City Council Meeting as part of the session.
March 1	Education Session – Begin the day with Eggs & Issues. Update on education facilities and what Guymon and Texas County has to offer.
March 15	County Government – This session focuses on Texas County Government and how it operates.
March 25 & 26	State Government Session – Overnight trip to Oklahoma City. Attend the NwOA Legislative Reception. Tour the capitol, visit with legislators and others that impact our communities. YOU ARE REQUIRED TO RIDE THE BUS TO & FROM OKLAHOMA CITY!
April 5	Economic Base Session – Learn about local banks & financial institutions, agribusiness, oil and gas and other industries.
April 12	Graduation Banquet – Bring your date for the celebration with your classmates, alumni, facilitators, Guymon Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors and Ambassadors.
